



43rd Annual Illinois Performance Tested Bull Sale



Health Requirements

Brucellosis – Since Illinois is a Brucellosis free state, bulls are not required to have a brucellosis test to sell.

Johne's Requirement – The IPT Bull Sale Johne's requirement will be met by one of the following testing methods: (1) The dam of the bull consigned must test negative for Johne's disease, OR if the dam is not available, 30 second lactation or higher cows must be tested. (2) Come from a herd that is a Level 1 or higher of the Voluntary Johne's Certification Program.

BVD Requirement - All bulls are tested for Bovine Viral Diarrhea (BVD) using the Persistently Infected (PI) ear notch screening system. The test results will be included in the buyer sale packet.

T.B. – Illinois is a Tuberculosis (TB) Free State. All sale bulls are eligible for immediate movement to Missouri.
